



## Cincinnati-Middletown, OH-KY-IN

- In the first half of 2007, the Cincinnati-Middletown metropolitan area was the 15th largest export market in the U.S., with sales totaling \$7.3 billion.
- Canada was a leading export destination for Cincinnati's exports of goods in the first half of 2007. Other leading destinations were Mexico and the Japan.
- In the first half of 2007, Cincinnati benefited from existing free trade agreements, exporting \$2.4 billion to Canada and Mexico, and \$66 million to the Central American and Dominican Republic region.
- Thirty-four percent of Cincinnati's merchandise exports go to NAFTA countries.
- Transportation equipment was the top Cincinnati export category for the first half of 2007, accounting for \$3.3 billion, or 46 percent, of exported goods.
- Other top exports were chemicals (\$1.0 billion, 14 percent); machinery, except electrical (\$757 million, 10 percent); and computer and electronic products (\$278 million, 4 percent).
